Gaziantep is located in the modern

Türkiye at the north-western tip of

Mesopotamia. It has a history dating

back to the Paleolithic Period and is



home to Hittite, Roman, Byzantine, Seljuq and Ottoman layers. Due to its special location on the Silk Road, the city grew rapidly after it passed into Ottoman reign in 1516 and the city became then a center where not only goods and money but also beliefs, traditions, thoughts and scientific knowledge were exchanged.

Today, with 2.154.051 inhabitants (2022's data), Gaziantep is a regional center and the top ten fastest growing cities in the world with its strong cultural, agricultural and commercial structure as well as its young and educated population. The current

economic structure of the city still relies on the trio of gastronomy, agriculture and commerce just like it did throughout history.
